

# Official Rule Sheet



## 2010 World's Largest Closest to the Flagstick Contest™

1. Contest will be held on August 21st with a rain date of August 28th
2. Play can take place at any time during the 21st or 28th and hours of competition are at the discretion of the participating club
3. Measuring devices are allowed but must be USGA competition conforming
4. Each player is only allowed one shot per \$10 donation
5. In case of inclement weather, contact 630-243-9483 or visit [bigpar3.com](http://bigpar3.com) for instruction
6. Yardage needs to be 150 for men, 120 for women and juniors
7. Measurements should be taken from the edge of the ball to the nearest edge of the hole, rounded UP to the nearest ½ inch increment, for example
  - > The following shot would measure 5 feet 3 and 1/2 inches
8. We recommend the area around the hole be flat (approximately 10' radius)
9. Please encourage the assistant superintendents and professionals at your facility to utilize this opportunity to get involved
10. Forms will be supplied that will capture the following classifications.
  - a. Closest measurements (prizes awarded to the overall winners of the following categories)
    - > Facility (Best ten combined player shots all ages determines facility score)
    - > Best overall male under 65
    - > Best overall female under 65
    - > Best overall male 65 and up
    - > Best overall female 65 and up
    - > Best overall female junior 18 and under
    - > Best overall male junior 18 and under
    - > Best overall club official (owner, green chairman, general manager, board member, etc)
    - > Best overall golf professional
    - > Best overall golf course superintendent
  - b. Names, email address, phone, and payment check off of participants
